

**PUBLIC MEETING**  
**September 16, 2003**

Chair Anita Varone called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Commissioners Murray and Tinsley were present. Others attending all or a portion of the meeting included Ron Alles, Sharon Haugen, Frank Rives, Jason Mohr, and Carole Byrnes.

Pledge of Allegiance. Everyone recited the pledge.

Request to Withdraw Proposed Hoeffner Minor Subdivision. Frank Rives reported that applicant Mary Faith Hoeffner has withdrawn her subdivision application. Ms. Hoeffner is interested in pursuing a family transfer. By consensus, the Commissioners acknowledged receipt of applicant's subdivision withdrawal request.

Other business.

Homeland Security Grant. Ron Alles reported the 6 million dollar request made on behalf of the city and the county for a radio project has been approved, but the 25% required soft match portion has been denied. Part of the match needs to be made up with cash. Staff proposes to do this with some E-9-1-1 monies as well as the county's public safety mill levy dedicated to radios, and may need to make an Intercap loan application. If the Commission agrees to the modification, staff will prepare a letter for commission signature. By consensus, the commissioners agreed to sign the letter.
